The Kokoda Track 15 Days



One of the world's most challenging walks through famous World War II battlefields

ITINERARY AND HIGHLIGHTS

- Day 1 Arrive in **Port Moresby** and transfer to hotel.
- Day 2 **Bomana War Cemetery**. Commence trek.
- Day 3-7 **Trek the Kokoda Track**, camping and staying in huts along the way.
- Day 8 **Free day on the trail at Myola**. Explore nearby waterfall and **war site**.
- Day 9-11 Continue trek, finishing at Kokoda.
- Day 12-13 Drive to **Buna**. **Cultural show**. Free day at beach for **boat trips, fishing or swimming**.
- Day 14 Fly from **Popondetta** to Port Moresby.
- Day 15 Trip ends in Port Moresby this morning.



The Kokoda Track was the scene of some of the bloodiest conflicts in the Second World War. Today it is one of the world's classic overland walks. Crossing the mountain ranges of Papua New Guinea, this is an arduous trek – only suitable for the fit, adventurous and prepared. The 90-kilometre trek crosses the mighty Owen Stanley Range, following the trail used during World War II. The trail crosses mountain passes, snakes along ridges and descends into deep gullies. Along the way we visit small, isolated villages, war sites, ancient forests and extinct volcanic craters. At the end of our trek, we'll celebrate our achievement with a couple of nights at the coastal village of Buna, where we have the chance to fish, swim, and canoe or just relax on the beach. If you are up for a challenge, this journey is constantly rewarding.
